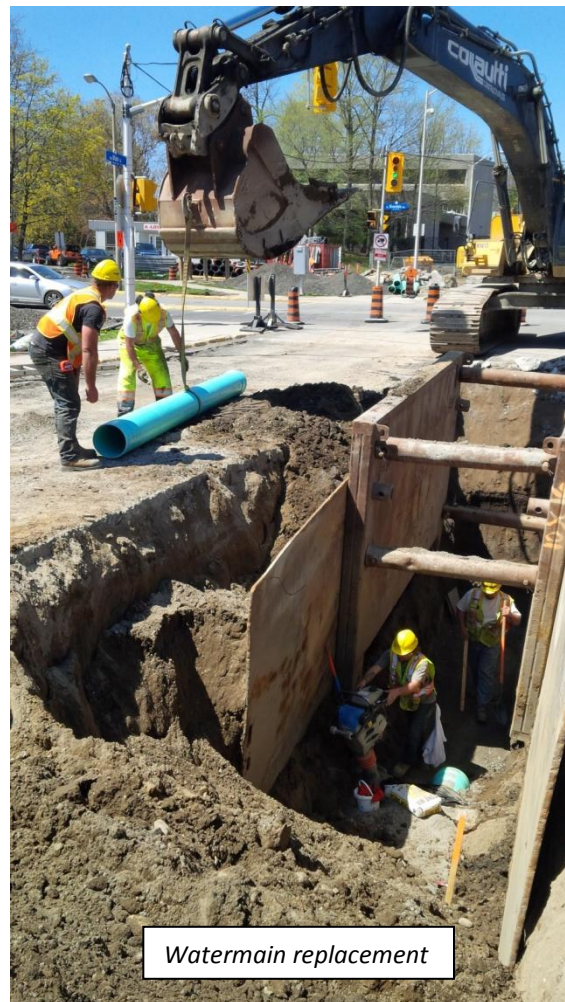

## On-Going

Here's a block-by-block breakdown of the work currently underway:

- **Harvey Street to Lees Avenue:** Road box excavation, concrete sidewalk at intersections, relocation of telecommunication cables and installation of brick pavers for sidewalk;
- **Lees Avenue to Clegg Street:** Grading of granular base for cycle track and paving of cycle track, concrete sidewalk at intersections and installation of brick pavers for sidewalk;
- **Clegg Street to the Rideau River:** Removal of asphalt and concrete road base, sanitary sewer and watermain replacement;
- **Brantwood Place Gates:** Removal of stone facing, and;
- **Rideau River Drive:** Replacement of lateral connections.

## Upcoming

Here are key **new** upcoming construction activities planned for the next two weeks:

- **Harvey Street to Clegg Street:** Preparation for soft landscaping;
- **Clegg Street to the Rideau River Drive:** Replacement of lateral connections;
- **Brantwood Place Gates:** Removal of existing concrete, and;
- **Rideau River Drive:** Watermain testing, electrical work and excavation for the retaining wall.

## Traffic

### Main Street

The northbound lane from Hawthorne Avenue to Harvey Street will remain closed until August. The northbound lane from Clegg Street to Lees Avenue will remain closed until September. The northbound lane from Riverdale Avenue to Clegg Street will remain closed until November.

### Colonel By Drive / Pretoria Bridge

Sunday Bikedays will take place every Sunday from May 15<sup>th</sup> to September 4<sup>th</sup> (except on May 29<sup>th</sup>). For these events, **Colonel By Drive will be closed to traffic from Hog's Back Road to the Laurier Bridge from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.**

The Floral Fireworks for the Canadian Tulip Festival will take place on Sunday May 22<sup>nd</sup>. For this event, **Colonel By Drive will be closed to traffic from Echo Drive (Bank Street access) to Clegg Street from 9 p.m. to 10 p.m.**

The Early Bird Triathlon, Duathlon & Colonel By Classic Run will take place on Saturday May 21<sup>st</sup>. For this event, **Colonel By Drive will be closed to traffic from Hog's Back Road to Clegg Street from 7 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.**

The Tamarack Ottawa Race Weekend will take place on Saturday May 28<sup>th</sup> and Sunday May 29<sup>th</sup>. For this event, the **Pretoria Bridge will be closed to traffic on Saturday May 28<sup>th</sup> from 3:30 p.m. to 8:45 p.m. and on Sunday May 29<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.** For this event, **Colonel By Drive will be closed to traffic (Hogs Back Road to Hawthorne Avenue) on Saturday May 28<sup>th</sup> from 3:30 p.m. to 8:45 p.m. and will be closed to traffic (Hawthorne Avenue to Rideau Street) on Sunday May 29<sup>th</sup> from 6:30 a.m. to 2 p.m.**
