- While committee members were absent from the meeting, the feeling was mixed on support.
 - Rick will go to the CA asking for funding for equipment to be lent to area residents.
- The idea of fruit trees for where the horseshoe pits were was put out. There is an
 Ottawa group that will pick the fruit and if area residents need the fresh fruit, which
 could be a source.

Brantwood
